SPECIMEN COLLECTION INSTRUCTIONS

Group B Streptoccocus or GBS

According to 2010 CDC recommendations, both the lower vagina and the rectum through the anal sphincter should be sampled to increase the detection of GBS colonization.

Indications

For the detection of GBS in pregnant women between 35-37 weeks gestation.


Specimen Required

Approved swab with collection from the lower vagina and rectum through the anal sphincter.


Supplies

• eSwab, liquid Amies or Stuart's media collection swab


Specimen Collection:



1. Remove swab from packaging. Insert swab 2cm into vagina, (front passage). Do not touch cotton end with fingers.



2. Insert the **same** swab 1cm into anus, (back passage).

3. After collection, carefully replace swab in container and label appropriately.

Please label the swab container with the patient's first and last name, second unique identifier, and the time of collec-
